PKI RE-ACTIVATION AT PAF HOSPITAL

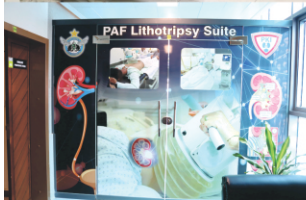

WORKING PROTOCOLS AT PAF HOSPITAL

PATIENT SCREENING

Patient coming for PKI either directly or referred by Physician has to undergo a detailed financial screening as per policy. Depending upon the financial status, the patient is offered either total free or partial payment for treatment. The screening re-checked by one the Three PKI directors if needed.




HEALTH CARE DELIVERY

After screening the patient, the patient is registered with PAF as PKI patient with unique medical record number for future reference.

For OPD visit, the patient on partial payment will pay Rs. 500 as consultation fee compared to Rs. 2500 for a private patient. Patient availing totally free services will not pay any fee.

For surgeries and admissions, the patients on partial payment will submit the pre-decided amount with manager PKI. Hospital will bill PKI for that patient, while patient at time of discharge will not pay any fee. Patient availing totally free services will not pay any fee.

There is no difference in treatment of PKI vs private patient in hospital as PKI is working as a panel like any other insurance panel. This ensures secrecy and let us to avoid hurting the self-respect of PKI patient.

PAKISTAN MONSOON FLOODS 2022

Pakistan was affected with the worst ever floods in the history of Pakistan submerging more than 50% of the land in the water, displacing millions of people, destroying infrastructure and causing thousands of casualties.



PKI FLOOD RELIEF DRIVE



PKI worked on the forefronts to help its brethren and partnered with sister organizations including Custom Health Care Society, Pakistan Air Force, Association of Physicians of Pakistani Descent of North America (APPNA) and Islamic Medical Association of North America (IMANA).



PKI with other partners served more than 10,000 patients, provided food for 9000 people, 257 tents and 3000 winter packages (blankets, quilts, shawls, sweaters and caps) from separate non-clinical funds.



PKI Flood Relief Campaign is still ongoing and is now focusing on Rehabilitation efforts in flood affected areas.

PKI-TÜRKIYE / SYRIA EARTH QUAKE RELIEF DRIVE 2023



PKI came forward to help Brethren in Türkiye & Syria hit by a massive 7.8 magnitude earthquake on February 6th 2023. Thousands are expected to have lost their lives, with countless more injured. Entire buildings collapsed and flattened, leaving hundreds of thousands displaced outside in the snow and cold. PKI worked on the forefronts to help its brethren and partnered with sister organizations including Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) & Sulemaniya Foundation.



Dr. Saeed Akhter himself visited the earthquake hit areas of Türkiye so as to coordinate and plan the relief efforts and has signed a MOU with Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) for earthquake relief work in Türkiye & Syria.



So far PKI has already sent 975Kg of medical supplies to Türkiye, donated Rs. 01 million as cash aid, started registration for volunteers for establishing medical camps and has launched an active fund raising campaign.

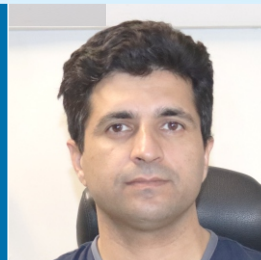

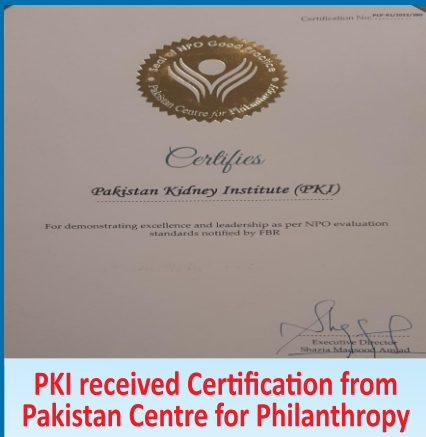
